Tuesday, 6 - 7 p.m.

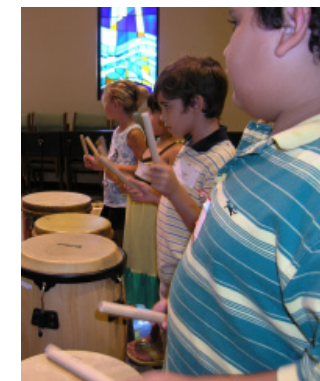
Age: 8 and above

Cost: \$10 per class. Call for details

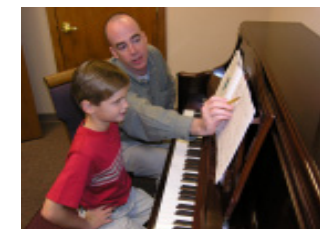


DUO (SHARED) LESSONS
